

Dr. Don Hickey - SNB Teaching Excellence Award

Congratulations to Dr. Don Hickey at Wayne State College on receiving the SNB Teaching Excellence Award this year.



Dr. Hickey is a professor of history at Wayne State and has been called the "dean of 1812 scholarship" by the New Yorker. He has written 11 books and more than 100 articles, mainly on the War of 1812. He has also taught at the Army Staff College, the Naval War College and the Citadel.

David Ley, Chairman of the Board, established the SNB Teaching Excellence Award in 1998 to recognize and strengthen outstanding teaching at WSC. The recipient receives a gift of \$1,200 from the bank. Congratulations Dr. Hickey and thank you for your efforts!
