What protocols will be in place for the Wayne Community Schools and Wayne State College this year in regards to COVID-19?

Wayne Community Schools classes start August 13, 2020. They have worked diligently to create a framework for how the schools will respond to the COVID-19 pandemic during the 2020-2021 school year to keep students and staff safe. You can visit wayneschools.org to read the Re-Opening plan. They will require each student wear a mask whenever social distancing isn't feasible.

Wayne State classes begin August 17, 2020 and the college intends to offer as many face-to-face opportunities as possible while following guidelines established by federal, state, and local authorities to prioritize public health. When returning to campus students and faculty will be encouraged to wear face coverings, maintain social distancing, and routinely self-monitor and assess.

We know these are challenging times, but we appreciate the efforts by our school leaders to prioritize the health and safety of students, staff and community. We're in this together!
