

## When is the solar eclipse in 2024?

Dr. Todd Young, director of the Fred Dale Planetarium at WSC and Professor of Astronomy and Physics at WSC, will talk to the Century Club before the March 15 movie of an upcoming eclipse of the sun on April 8th this year. In Nebraska it will only be a partial eclipse. The last time there was an eclipse we could see in NE was in 2017 and that was a full one near Grand Island. He hopes to set up a viewing on April 8th (time to be announced in April newsletter) in the WSC football stadium to see the eclipse. Recently he spoke at Rotary and explained how the sun, earth, and moon rotate and create the various changes in seasons and moon visibility. The earth revolves around the sun in a year and the moon revolves around the earth in a month. He emphasized to NEVER look directly at the sun because the UV rays will instantly damage your eyes. We are so fortunate to have an expert in Wayne to share his knowledge of this fantastic astronomical event! Come to the movie March 15 to learn more.
