Originally from Omaha, McKinsie attended Wayne State College and enjoys spending time with her husband, Jordan, and walking their dogs.

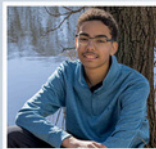

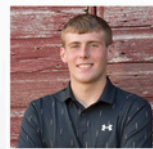

Who received the Zero Hero Award from the Wayne Green Team?

The Wayne Green Team presented Micah's Closet with its Zero Hero award, recognizing outstanding work in reducing, reusing, and recycling in Wayne.

Owned by the First United Methodist Church, Micah's Closet has been operating since 2012. It accepts donations of clothing for resale to all family members. It also sells gently used toys and stuffed animals during the holiday season. Most items are \$3 or less. The store is run by amazing volunteers who keep it open five days a week.

Micah's Closet has a significant impact on reducing waste. With more than 100 customers per month, the store saves 14,000 pounds of clothing and shoes from going to the landfill each year. It also provides help in emergencies, such as with house fires, or with Haven House, the schools, and the health department.

Store volunteers Sue Schroeder and Linda Teach were on our trip last month, so they couldn't be there in person to accept the award. Thank you, Sue, Linda, and all the other volunteers for your work at Micah's Closet, and congratulations to Micah's Closet on being a Zero Hero in Wayne!
